2023 – 2024 Tuition Assistance Agreement

Cornerstone Christian Schools' purpose is to develop and train the whole person spiritually, intellectually, physically and socially with unprecedented excellence in a Christ-centered culture.

Tuition Assistance is limited and may be available to those families who meet the eligibility requirements. Completing a FAST application is not a guarantee that assistance will be granted.

If tuition assistance is granted for the 2023-2024 school year it is pursuant to the following conditions:

- 1. The family is expected to demonstrate an alignment with the Cornerstone Christian Schools' values and statement of purpose.
- 2. The family is expected to positively support Cornerstone Christian Schools.
- 3. The family is expected to actively support and comply with the Cornerstone Christian Schools Student/Parent Handbook and other CCS activity specific handbooks/procedures/policies.
- 4. The tuition assistance amount granted must be kept confidential and not discussed with others.
- 5. The student remains enrolled for the 2023-2024 school year. Withdrawal from the school may result in a pro-rated portion or forfeiture of the award.

Failure to adhere to the above items may result in termination of enrollment.

Tuition Assistance, if awarded, will be credited to your financial account to offset the 2023-2024 tuition charge for the student(s). This award is not transferable, non-refundable and applies only to school tuition. The parent/guardian is responsible to pay all other expenses and charges in accordance with the CCS tuition contract. Other expenses and charges include, but are not limited to, any remaining tuition balance, uniforms, cafeteria, fees, ancillary academic services and merchandise charges.

Cornerstone Christian Schools reserves the right to change or cancel the tuition assistance program without notice.
