Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv, a modern city built on the ancient port of **Jaffa** overlooking the majestic **Mediterranean Sea**. Board state-of-the-art motor coaches and enjoy a Honey Cake Welcome enroute to **Tiberias**. Travel inland through the scenic Galilean mountains to Tiberias, where you will spend three nights on the beautiful shores of the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 3 | WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 8

DAY 7 | SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 12

Up to Jerusalem

Begin this exciting day with a scenic drive that leads to the Holy City of Jerusalem. Take in the panoramic view of Jerusalem from atop the Mount of Olives where Jesus stood when He presented His "prophecy seminar" of Matthew 24. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus often met with His disciples (Mark 14:32), prayed (Luke 22: 39-44) and was betrayed (John 18:1-8). Enter the walled Old City through the Lion's Gate located in the Christian Quarter for a Sunday morning anointing service at St. Anne's Church, filled with praise, worship, and communion hosted by Pastor Hagee and Pastor Matt. See the healing Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the paralytic (John 5:1-8). Have a time of personal prayer and reflection at the Kotel, the Western Wall, the only remains of the First and Second Temples. And finally experience a fascinating tour of the Western Wall Tunnels.

DAY 8 | MONDAY, NOVEMBER 13

City of King David and the Pilgrim's Road

Enjoy a morning visit to the Model of Jerusalem at the Israel Museum and hear a special presentation by Pastor Matt. Continue to the restored Jewish Quarter of the Old City through the Jaffa Gate. Visit the famous Cardo, Jerusalem's main thoroughfare during the Roman and Byzantine areas. Explore Ir David, the City of King David (2 Samuel 5:9), with an exciting journey through excavations, fortresses and passageways, including the newly excavated "Pilgrims Road". Next experience the Upper Room, site of the Last Supper (Mark 14:13-15). After dinner, evening shuttles will be available for shopping at the famed Ben Yehuda Street.

Into the Judean Desert

Begin this adventurous day with a drive into the spectacular Judean wilderness and ascend by cable car to Masada to experience King Herod's desert palace and the last stronghold of the Jewish zealots against the Roman domination in 73AD. Visit the Qumran ruins and see the famous caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Enjoy a unique swim in the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth at almost 1,300 feet below sea level, before returning to Jerusalem.

DAY 10 | WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 15

Shalom to the Promised Land

Today we visit the memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem. Explore the Jerusalem Archaeological Park and the Southern Steps, leading to the Golden Gate, the southern entrance to the Temple Mount. You will visit the Garden Tomb, traditional site of Jesus' burial and resurrection, and experience an inspirational time of personal reflection. Your afternoon is available for additional shopping and packing. After a Farewell Dinner, we will transfer to the airport and depart to the United States. (B, D)

REPEATER TRACK SITES

Designed for travelers who have previously toured Israel. Includes the following sites in addition to select events on the Pilgrim Track.

AYALON INSTITUTE - Disguised as a kibbutz which ran a laundry service, this was actually operated as a secret ammunition factory which was established by the Jewish underground during the British Mandate.

BEIT SHE'ARIM – Founded at the end of the 1st century BC during the reign of King Herod. After the destruction of the Second Temple in 70 AD, the Sanhedrin migrated from place to place and finally settled in this ancient Roman city which is also a place of Jewish burial catacombs.

BETHLEHEM - Located in the "hill country" of Judea, Biblical Ephrath, is referenced in the Bible as the village where the matriarch Rachel died and was buried "by the wayside" (Genesis 48:7), in the Book of Micah as the birthplace of Jesus, Israel's coming King (Micah 5:2), the Book of Ruth, where Ruth gleaned the fields of Boaz (Ruth 1:22), in the Books of Samuel, where Bethlehem is mentioned as the home of Jesse, the father of King David and the site of David's anointing by the prophet Samuel, and where David's mighty men drew water for him after the victory over the Philistines. (1 Samuel 17:58; 1 Samuel 16:1-13; 2 Samuel 23:15-16).

CANA – The site of the Marriage at Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle of turning water into wine as recorded in the Gospel of John (John 2:1-10).

CARMEL MARKET (Shuk Ha'Carmel) - A fascinatingly vibrant marketplace, the largest in Tel Aviv, where traders sell everything from delicious food, spices, and fruit, to jewelry, clothing and electronics.

DEGANIA ALEF – Known as "the mother of all kibbutzim", this Jewish settlement started in 1910, making it the earliest Zionist farming commune in Israel.

EIN KEREM - A charming hillside village famed for its centuries-old holy sites, to include the Church of St. John the Baptist, containing a cave which is said to be the place of his birth (Luke 1:57-63).

ELIJAH'S CAVE - A grotto on Mount Carmel, associated with the prophet Elijah. Believed to have been where Elijah prayed before challenging the priests of Baal (1 Kings 18).

EMEK TZURIM PARK - Participate in the incredible operation of the Temple Mount Sift Project, where you might unearth an ancient treasure. The seal of King Hezekiah, an Egyptian amulet from the days of the Pharaohs, Babylonian arrowheads, jewels, mosaic stones and coins are only some of the exciting discoveries found over the years at this amazing sifting project.

KURSI – This picturesque site located at the foothill of the Golan Heights, on the eastern side of the Sea of Galilee, commemorates the Miracle of the Swine (Matthew 8:28-33).

MT. BENTAL – Located in the middle of the Golan Heights, towards the Syrian border, this is one of Israel's favorite mountain peaks, due to the great panoramic views of the Golan and Syria and because it was the site of a courageous battle fought during Israel's war for the Golan.

NAZARETH - According to the Gospel of Luke, Nazareth was the home of Mary as well as the site of the Annunciation (Luke 1:26-29). The Gospel of Matthew records that Joseph and Mary resettled in Nazareth after returning from the flight from Bethlehem to Egypt (Matthew 2:19-22).

OLD JAFFA - First Mentioned in the book of Joshua and later as the port used by Solomon to build the Temple (2 Chronicles 2:16), where Jonah left for Tarshish (Jonah 1:3), and again as port-of-entry for the cedars of Lebanon for the Second Temple of Jerusalem (Ezra 3:7). In the New Testament, Jaffa is where Tabitha (Dorcas) was brought back to life by Peter (Acts 9:36), and the place where God gave Peter the vision of the unclean animals (Acts 11:4-17).

PILGRIMS ROAD – One of the latest excavations of the City of David, the Jerusalem Pilgrims Road is a late Roman period "stepped street" connecting the Temple Mount from its southwestern corner to Jerusalem's southern gates via the Pool of Siloam.

POOL OF SILOAM – Built by King Hezekiah as a source of water when he created an ingenious tunnel to divert water from the Gihon Spring located outside the city wall (2 Chronicles 32). An important ritual bath during the time of Christ. It is where Jesus told the blind man to wash before regaining his sight as recorded in the Book of John (John 9:11).

SAFED - According to the Book of Judges, this area belonged to the Tribe of Naphtali. Safed is considered one of Judaism's four Holy Cities and is known for its historic synagogues, Torahs and Jewish modern art.

SHILOH – An ancient Canaanite town in Samaria which became the central sanctuary site of the Israelite confederacy during the time of Judges (12th–11th century BC). After the Israelite conquest of Canaan, the Tabernacle which contained the Ark of the Covenant was located in Shiloh until the Ark was captured by the Philistines. Shiloh is where Hannah prayed for a son, and He answered her with the birth of the prophet Samuel (Joshua 18:1, 1 Samuel 1:1-22).

SISTERS OF ZION – A convent which encompasses a portion of the Triumphal Arch originally constructed by the Roman emperor Hadrian in the 2nd century. The convent's basement holds an impressive reservoir built by Hadrian in the moat of Herod's older Antonia fortress; a small collection of ancient artifacts; and the famous lithostratos etched with games played by Roman legionnaires (Matthew 27:27-38).

ZEDEKIAH'S CAVE – The legendary site of King Solomon's quarry located beneath the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem. The Bible records that King Zedekiah and his army fled through a secret tunnel located in this cave when the Babylonians came to conquer Jerusalem (2 Kings 25:4-5).

TOUR #1 APPOLONIA, TEL AVIV & JAFFA







8:30AM departure from hotel. This tour commences with a drive along the scenic Via Maris or "Way of the Sea", an ancient coastal trade route. First stop is **Apollonia National Park**, an ancient city in Hellenistic and Roman Judea, situated on a cliff above the Mediterranean Sea. Walk through the park, which houses the remnants of a thirteenth century Crusader fortress and the remains of a Roman villa. Afterward, proceed to **Tel Aviv**, a bustling city rich in culture. Begin along the **Rothschild Boulevard** and admire the original Bauhaus buildings, named a UNESCO World Heritage Town. Next, drive down **Ibn Gvirol Street** named after one of Israel's most famous poets and end at the **Tel Aviv Art Museum**, **Golda Meir Center** and **Yitzhak Rabin Plaza**. Onto the ancient port of **Jaffa** with its cobblestone streets and beautiful art galleries. Enter **Old Jaffa**, see the clock tower from the Ottoman Period, mosques, churches and the towns exotic flee market. Return to the hotel later this afternoon.

TOUR #2 HAIFA, MOUNT CARMEL & ACRE







8:30AM departure from hotel. Begin the tour with a drive to the top of **Mount Carmel**, which offers spectacular panoramic views of **Haifa**, capital of the north, and one of Israel's main commercial ports. See the world famous **Bahai Gardens** and the remarkable **Persian Gardens**. Continue along the shores of the Mediterranean Sea toward **Acre** (Akko). Upon arrival, experience the medieval atmosphere and descend into the headquarters of the Knights of St. John. Returning to the surface, explore the Ottoman period of Acre's (Akko's) long and colorful history by visiting the lively marketplace with its exotic offerings and intoxicating scents. End with a visit to the picturesque **Pisan Port**, which was built by Crusader seamen from Pisa, Italy. Return to the hotel later this afternoon.

TOUR #3 HAROD SPRING & BEIT SHE'AN







8:30AM departure from hotel. Begin the tour with a drive to Harod Spring. Harod Spring is the Biblical "Spring which is in Jezreel", where Israelite King Saul prepared his army before the Battle of Gilboa. This is the same site where Gideon and the Israelite army camped right before their war with the Midianites. Then, continue onto Beit She'an. Beit She'an is one of the oldest cities in Israel. The name appears in the Bible several times and is famous as the site where King Saul and his sons hung from the city walls. The city remained a significant metropolis during the reign of King David and King Solomon. The Hellenistic period followed when the city was renamed Scythopolis after Dionysus' nurse. She was believed to have been buried here. View the history of Israel through the archaeological remains from each historic period, which provides a clear picture of what the city would have looked like. This former Roman metropolis was home to 30,000 to 40,000 citizens and covered approximately 370 acres. View the impressive Roman Theater, continue to the ancient street below called "Palladius". Follow the street in a northern direction to the bottom of the tale where you'll see some of the major monuments of the area including a Roman Temple Nymphaeum. Walk the roman streets of Beit She'an and hear the echos of the past. Return to the hotel later this afternoon.

AIR TRANSPORTATION FROM NEW YORK

(JFK-John F. Kennedy International Airport) or NEWARK ((EWR-Newark Liberty International Airport)

- The roundtrip airfare included in the tour price is based on the excursion rate in effect at the time of printing and is subject to change.
- Air tickets: Cancellations and refunds are governed by the tariff applying to the airfare and/or other tariffs of the airlines concerned. Airfare is non-refundable once ticketed.

BAGGAGE FOR INTERNATIONAL FLIGHT
